### Code of Conduct

By signing this Application Form, student formally agrees to abide by the Code of Conduct and thereby contribute to the success of the tour. This code of behaviour covers both the time leading up to and including the trip. Failure to abide by this code of behaviour could result in:

- exclusion from the trip
- a direct response from staff on the tour
- a meeting with Principal on return to Perth.

**Severe breaches of this code will mean instant return to Perth with all flight and transport costs being met by the parents/students.**

### Before the Trip

- No student will be allowed to attend the 2024 Indonesia Study Tour if they have been suspended during the time leading up to the tour. The deposit will be forfeited but all remaining amounts will be refunded where possible.
- Students are expected to attend all meetings concerning the trip. If they are away on the day of a meeting it is the student's responsibility to find out what they have missed. If meetings are consistently missed, the student's place on the trip will be revoked.
- All assignments are to be handed in PRIOR to leaving.
- It is expected that all school fees be up to date.
- Students must have a general level of health and fitness (as they will be on their feet all day and students must be able to walk an average of 1.5km per day)

### During the trip

- Whilst we are away, we are representing Mother Teresa Catholic College. Manners are to be used at all times without hesitation or complaint.
- All instructions from the guides and teachers are to be followed at all times.
- Use of inappropriate language is not acceptable.
- Students are responsible for their own belongings. The teachers will not take any responsibility for student possessions, especially money and phones.

- Mobile phones are to be on silent at all times. Social Media is not to be accessed during the trip and phone can only be used for purposes other than taking photos (using the camera feature and not snapchat) at designated times.
- Lights out means go to sleep...not sit up and chat.
- Keep your room tidy at all times as you are sharing you need to avoid trip hazards.
- Sleeping areas of the opposite sex are out of bounds.
- Drugs, smoking, or alcohol are unacceptable.
- A teacher must know where you are at all times. You are not to leave the site at any time without the permission of a teacher and must be with a partner at all times.
- Adhere to the rules set out in the different locations and the accommodation.
